

## **Camping Lot Schedule, Policies and Procedures**

September 30 – October 6, 2025 (v8/27/25)

#### Schedule

Tue., 9/30 9am-9pm Early Bird Camping (\$125)

Wed., 10/1 9am General Camping Opens (\$100)

Mon., 10/6 12pm Camping area closes

Please have your area clean and exit

#### **Camping Permits**

- 1. Camping Permits are required to camp and may only be obtained at the Camping Center upon arrival. **Cash Only.**
- 2. Each camping pass purchased through Thursday includes two (2) general admission passes to the October 2, Thursday Thunder event.
- 3. Early-bird camping arriving Tuesday at 5pm or after is \$125.
- 4. General Camping arriving on Wednesday or after is \$100

## **Procedures and Regulations**

- 1. Once open, the lot remains open 24 hours per day until the event concludes
- 2. Camping permit must be purchased at camping center upon arrival.
- 3. Camping is available on a first come-first served basis. If the camping lot reaches capacity, the adjacent Virgilio's Event Center becomes a secondary camping lot.
- 4. All campers should enter the grounds using the north spectator entrance upon arrival and check in at the camping center.
- 5. All campers must be registered using the form attached. Campers are encouraged to complete the registration form ahead and present to the camping center upon arrival.
- 6. After successful registration, our camping attendants will take you to the next available camping spot.
- 7. There are no reserved spots, however, our camping attendants will attempt to put you in the space of your choice.

- 8. You must park on your lot as instructed by our camping staff, and once parked, it must remain that way for the weekend.
- 9. Race teams, please leave your hauler in the pits if you are staying overnight. Do not park in other campsites or a roadway in the camping area.
- 10. The lot is dry camping only with no electric, sewer or water hookups available.
- 11. Please maintain at least 10' between campers including your awnings.
- 12. No awning-to-awning set-ups.
- 13. Campfires are permitted but please keep them contained to a 30" maximum fire ring.
- 14. Absolutely no dis-charging on speedway property. Violators will be expelled.
- 15. Please clean up your camping area and dispose of your trash in the dumpster provided in the parking lot.
- 16. Move-out is Monday by 12pm.
- 17. 2am is quiet time each night.
- 18. Motorized recreational vehicles (i.e Mini-bikes/Golf Carts/ATV's) are strictly prohibited.
- 19. Potable water is available at the camping center.
- Campers in need of service while on property can call our partner RVMD

- 21. Portable toilets and hand wash stations are conveniently placed around the camping area for your use.
- 22. The Speedway goes to great lengths with state and local agencies to maintain the proper permitting to allow overnight stays. Please respect the property and the policies established. Failure to abide by the rules contained herein may warrant expulsion from the lot.

We are granted the use of this lot courtesy of the owner, who has been very supportive of our events and Outlaw Weekend. However, please help us maintain that good relationship so we may continue to use the property in the future.
